Book Store – The Books & More store continues to blossom under the management of **Julie Gervais**. If you have not yet visited the store at 1513 N. Norma, please drop by during open hours of 10 to 2, Wednesday through Saturday. The store has been well received by our members and the general public, and received many compliments. The store offers art and gift items in addition to books. In fact, these non-book items account for approximately 40% of all sales.

Unfortunately, however, the store is not yet profitable. We are hopeful that the upcoming opening of a soft serve/health food store next door will result in more customers for us. In addition, we will be having several special events at the store such as book signings, artist demos, and special sales for members. So, watch your email and our Facebook page to take advantage of these events.

Board Openings – Election of officers will occur at the November meeting which will be held in the <u>Conference Room of the District 1 Supervisor's Office and NOT the library's Community Room due to the closure for renovation! The address is 400 N China Lake Blvd.</u>

Q: After you close on 11/1/25, what are we able to do during Express and Curbside hours?

A: While the building is closed to the public, here is a list of services we will be able to help with:

- * Return library materials
- * Pick up library materials (holds, requested grab bag, park pass)
- * Request specific library materials
- * Request Grab Bag (to pick up later)
- * Sign up for a library card
- * Limited browsing selection on days with nice weather
- * Reading Dragons (sign up/pick up
- * 1000 Books Before Kindergarten (sign up/pick up pins)
- * Business Services: wireless prints
 ONLY (no prints from a USB),
 photocopies, faxes; CASH preferred for
 quickest service)

- * Carryout activity bag (as supply lasts)
 - + Early Learners (3-5 yrs) weekly starting on Wednesdays 11/5
 - + Kids (6-10 yrs) weekly starting on Wednesdays 11/5
 - + Tween/Teen (11-18 yrs) monthly on 11/19 and 12/17
 - + Adult (19+ yrs) monthly on 11/19 and 12/17
- * Use wi-fi outdoors only
- * Drop off limited quantity of book, DVD, puzzle donations for the Friends of the Ridgecrest Branch Library
- * Drop off plastic bags
- * Pick up Narcan and/or fentanyl testing strips (fill out anonymous form)

By the time you are seeing this, our library branch will be closed to the public to start the renovation work from the **Building Forward Library Facilities** Improvement Program. We were awarded just over \$1 million to make infrastructure improvements, so our branch is closed to the public from 11/5/2025 through 1/19/2026. Some of our renovations include:new doors and windows, an updated front entrance area, security cameras in the public areas and at the entrances, and light switches for the public areas (which is something staff is MOST excited about because we have been using breaker box switches for decades).

Our closure will last about 2.5 months. (It includes multiple days when the library would regularly be closed for other planned closures.) (cont.p.4).

We understand the extended closure makes many anxious, but rest assured that library staff will still provide basic services and people will still be able to check out library materials. The format will be a little different than what you are used to over the past few years, but we will do what we can within our limitations to provide the same level of service as usual. (See the graphic on page 3.)

Express service will be offered Wednesdays through Saturdays from 11:30 am through 3:30 pm and will have a staff member sitting outside of our staff entrance for walk up service, unless there is inclement weather. **Curbside service** will be offered Wednesdays through Fridays from 11:30 am through 6 pm and

Q: I don't always know what I want to read until I see it. What about browsing for books?

A: We will offer browsing opportunities when weather permits during Express hours (Wed-Sat from 11:30 am-3:30 pm). During browsing, we will take general requests for future browsing (most likely for the next week). For instance, adult mysteries, YA fantasy, kids non-fiction animal books. We will try to honor requests but cannot guarantee anything.

We will also have a mini book display featuring a variety of topics and also new arrivals to our branch.

Q: I don't mind trying out new books or genres. What do you suggest?

A: We will offer grab bags. On some days, we will have some already prepared to choose from. For instance, we might have kids graphic novels, YA horror, new adult romance fiction, or picture books about dogs. We are able to create grab bags based on your requests for pick up on a future day.

Q: Where do I go for Express or Curbside service? Do I use the regular doors?

A: Express (walk up) and Curbside (call to schedule AND call when you arrive) services will be available through our STAFF ENTRANCE AREA on the courthouse access road.

EXPRESS:

Wed-Sat 11:30 am-3:30 pm Park in the dirt or parking lot and walk up to the staff entrance area indicated in red on the map.

CURBSIDE:

Wed-Fri 11:30 am-6 pm
Sat 11:30 am-3:30 pm
Call ahead to schedule and call on arrival for staff to bring items to your vehicle. Vehicles can be parked along the curb in the blue area FOR CURBSIDE ONLY.
